Creating with the Story Elements

Directions: Thinking about the story elements of character, setting, and plot in a novel is very important to understanding what is happening and why. Complete **one** of the following activities about what you've read so far. Be creative and have fun!

Characters

Draw a picture of what you think Charles Wallace's or Meg's room looks like. Include details that are specific to the character. At the bottom of the picture, write a creative name for your picture that reflects the character's personality.

Setting

Create a map of the setting so far in the book. Your map should include the Murry house, the dilapidated house of the Mrs Ws, Meg's school, and the apple orchard. Be sure that your map is detailed. Label the map clearly so that others know what you've created.

Plot

Create a visual storyboard that shows what major events have happened so far. (If you'd prefer, you can create a written flow chart instead.) Don't include the minor details. For these three chapters, you should probably have about five to seven events.
